MINNESOTANS ARE LOSING JOBS

Minnesotans in jobs most affected by economic shutdowns were cost-burdened before COVID-19 and **are rapidly losing their income**. These jobs include retail sales and food service.



RENTERS ARE FALLING BEHIND

Even with unemployment support, our lowest income renters will fall behind on rent, **a position from which most cannot recover**.



AFFORDABLE HOUSING IS AT RISK

When renters don't pay landlords, landlords can't keep the doors open. This could lead to the **collapse of rental markets in Minnesota**, and the loss of massive amounts of affordable housing.



HOUSING ASSISTANCE WILL SAVE PEOPLE AND HOMES

Housing assistance will **prevent mass displacement** of renters, and **loss of affordable housing** through foreclosure, condemnation, and low-bid sales. Strategic and bold assistance now will result in renters staying in their homes, housing providers keeping affordable properties where they are needed, and Minnesotans weathering this storm.
